

# 15 Must-Ask Preschool Tour Questions

These questions help you quickly separate high-quality preschool programs from average ones.

## 1. What is your teacher-to-child ratio?

Lower ratios mean more attention, better supervision, and stronger relationships.

## 2. Are all teachers licensed and background-checked?

In California, this is essential - not optional.

## 3. How long have your teachers worked here?

Low staff turnover usually signals a healthy, supportive environment.

## 4. What does a typical day look like?

Ask for a daily schedule, not a vague description.

## 5. How do you handle behavioral challenges?

Look for guidance, communication, and emotional support - not punishment.

## 6. How do you help new children adjust?

A thoughtful transition plan is a huge plus.

## 7. What curriculum or learning approach do you use?

Play-based, structured, or blended - clarity matters.

## 8. How do you prepare children for kindergarten?

Listen for social, emotional, and routine-based readiness - not just academics.

## 9. How do you communicate with parents?

Daily updates, photos, apps, or face-to-face conversations build trust.

## 10. What safety procedures are in place?

Ask about drop-off security, emergencies, and supervision at all times.

**11. How often are classrooms cleaned and sanitized?**

Cleanliness is non-negotiable for young children.

**12. Are meals and snacks provided?**

If yes, ask about nutrition and allergy policies.

**13. Is outdoor play part of every day?**

Physical activity is critical for development.

**14. What is your sick-child policy?**

Clear health rules protect everyone.

**15. Can I speak with current parents or read reviews?**

Transparency is a strong trust signal.
